### **A direct response to falsehoods proliferated by the Windsor-Essex medical coalition**

Concerned Windsor-Essex constituents, critical of the covid injection and related mandates, will be hosting a demonstration at the Windsor-Essex County Health Unit (WECHU) on Monday August 15, from 2 to 6 PM.

On August 3, we held a demonstration outside pediatrician Huma Kazmie's office, to address her history of making discriminatory and false statements in the press. A coalition of area medical organizations reacted to our demonstration by lying in a press release, alleging that protesters intimidated patient families and blocked access to Kazmie's office. In reality, protesters were perfectly peaceful and unobstructive.

Acting Medical Officer of Health Shanker Nesathurai corroborated the coalition's lies, and in a statement to media, advised protesters to be "cognizant of the impact" of our protest on families. He said, "I would ask that, moving forward, those who choose to articulate their grievances and disagreements do so at venues that don't affect the care of children and their families."

We ask that medical professionals avoid initiating conflict in the first place, by refraining from publicizing discriminatory views and medical disinformation.

In spite of the defamatory nature of the medical coalition's allegations, and in diplomatic acknowledgement of Nesathurai's request, our next protest will take place at the WECHU rather than a clinic. **We invite Nesathurai to acknowledge our diplomacy by attending the peaceful protest to speak with our representatives directly and in person.**

We will attend the WECHU on Monday August 15, from 2 to 6 PM.
